- What is your timeline?

- Do you have specific ideas or inspiration for the space?
 - A snapshot of your taste is extremely helpful to the designer when beginning to create a design board or plan
 - A better alignment with the designer's style and taste will help the relationship moving forward and make the process a smoother one for all involved.
- How involved do you want to be in the decision making process?
 - A hands off approach still requires some communication
 - How you work helps the designer to communicate his/her process best
 - An adequate understanding of the process will help to keep everyone at ease as each phase comes in to play.
- Have you worked with a designer before?
 - Was the designer difficult to work with/communicate with?
 - Conversations about past projects can help future work be more successful.
- Who will be the primary decision maker for the project?
 - One main point of contact is most helpful for communication purposes.
 - Knowing who will sign off on invoices and making decisions will allow for a smoother process all around.
